Our Commitment to Privacy

Your privacy is important to us. To better protect your privacy we provide this notice explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is collected and used.

Brief Summary – We do not sell, rent, lease, or give away any of your information with anyone that doesn't need it i.e. third-parties. For more details see Disclosure of Information to Outside Parties below.

What Information Do We Collect?

We collect information from you when you register on our site, place an order for installation, any follow-up trips, or request the removal of our equipment.

When using our website (initial registration, or ordering a service) you may be asked to enter your name, e-mail address, broker, mailing address, phone number(s) or credit card information.

On some pages, you can submit information about other people. For example, if you refer one of your colleagues to our company, you may need to submit the recipient's name, email address, address, phone number or Broker. You will NEVER be required to submit someone else's credit/debit card information.

Google, as a third party vendor, uses cookies. Google's use of the DART cookie enables it to serve ads to your users based on their visits to your sites and other sites on the Internet. Users may opt out of the use of DART cookies by visiting the Google ad and content network privacy policy.



Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Geaux Post. This information can include, but not limited to such things as: your IP address, browser type, domain name, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service to maintain quality of the service and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Geaux Post website.

How we may use your information

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one or more of the following ways:

They DO NOT collect your name, address, email address, or telephone number. We DO NOT disclose anything that could be used to personally identify you to those individuals.

Our Commitment to Data Security



To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

We offer the use of a secure server. All supplied sensitive information, such as credit/debit card numbers, is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and then encrypted into our Payment gateway providers database only to be accessible by those authorized with special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential.

After a transaction, your private information (credit cards, social security numbers, financials, etc.) will NOT be stored on our servers.

Disclosure of Information to Outside Parties

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others rights, property, or safety. However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.

Use of Cookies
